This Notice is to inform you that the State University of New York Board of Trustees (the "SUNY Trustees"), in its capacity as a charter authorizer, has received applications to revise the charters of the charter schools listed below. Further, the SUNY Trustees, or their designees, the SUNY Charter Schools Committee or SUNY Charter Schools Institute (the "Institute"), anticipate consideration of these requests as soon October 1, 2021. A description of the proposed action follows:

- **Bronx Charter School for Excellence**, an education corporation with the authority to operate more than one school requests the following enrollment revisions:
 - O Bronx Charter School of Excellence 4, located at 4300 Murdock Avenue, Bronx, NY 10466 in Community School District ("CSD") 11, chartered to serve 450 students in grades K-4 for the 2021-22 school year and 540 students in grades K-5 for the 2022-23 school year, the last year of the current charter term, requests an enrollment decrease to serve 300 students in grades K-4 for the 2021-22 school year growing to serve 360 students in grades K-5 for the 2022-23 school year.
 - O Bronx Charter School of Excellence 5, located at 1946 Bathgate Avenue, Bronx, NY 10457 in CSD 9, chartered to serve 360 students in grades K-3 for the 2021-22 school year growing to serve 540 students in grades K-5 for the 2023-24 school year, the final year of the current charter term, requests an enrollment decrease to serve 240 students in grades K-3 for the 2021-22 school year growing to serve 360 students in grades K-5 for the 2023-24 school year.

- **DREAM Charter School**, an education corporation with the authority to operate three schools:
 - DREAM Charter School, located at 1991 Second Avenue, New York, NY, 10029; 1991
 Second Avenue, New York, NY 10029; and, 439 East 115th Street, New York, NY 10029 in CSD 4:
 - DREAM Charter School Mott Haven, 411 Wales Avenue, Bronx, NY 10454 in CSD 7;

 - DREAM Charter School Highbridge, opening in the 2022-23 school year to be located in CSD 9:

seeks to add an at-risk preference to its admissions policies for the 2022-23 school year and beyond providing a preference for students enrolled in the Harlem RBI program.

- **KIPP NYC Public Charter Schools**, an education corporation with the authority to operate more than one school requests the following enrollment revision:
 - KIPP Bronx Charter School II, located at 501 Gerard Avenue, Bronx, NY 10451 in CSD 7, chartered to serve 370 students in grades K-1 and 5-6 for the 2021-22 school year growing to serve 735 students in grades K-3 and 5-8 for the 2023-24 school year, the final year of the current charter term, requests an enrollment decrease to serve 175 students in grades K and 6 for the 2021-22 school year growing to serve 697 students in grades K-2 and 5-8 for the 2023-24 school year
- **Storefront Academy Charter School**, an education corporation with the authority to operate more than one school requests the following enrollment revision:
 - O Storefront Academy Harlem Charter School, located at 70 East 129th Street, New York, NY 10035 in CSD 5, chartered to serve 200 students in grades K-3 for the 2021-22 school year growing to serve 300 students in grades K-5 for the 2023-24 school year, the final year of the current charter term, requests an enrollment decrease to serve 100 students in grades K-3 for the 2021-22 school year growing to serve 150 students in grades K-5 for the 2023-24 school year.
