## **UPDATED PUBLIC NOTICE**

SUBJECT: Second Notice of Charter Revisions – SUNY Trustee Approval

**DATE:** October 13, 2021

This updated Notice, pursuant to New York Education Law § 2857(1), is to inform you that the State University of New York Board of Trustees (the "SUNY Trustees"), in its capacity as a charter authorizer, approved the following charter revision requests:

- Achievement First Brooklyn Charter Schools, an education corporation with the authority to operate more than one school requests the following enrollment revisions:
  - O Achievement First Legacy Charter School, located at 118-49 Montauk Street, Queens, NY 11412 in Community School District ("CSD") 29, chartered to serve 180 students in grades K-1 for the 2021-22 school year and 732 students in grades K-7 for the 2025-26 school year, the final year of the current charter term, requests an enrollment decrease to serve 90 students in grade K for the 2021-22 school year growing to serve 450 students in grades K-4 for the 2025-26 school year.
  - Achievement First Linden Charter School, located 800 Van Siclen Avenue, Brooklyn, NY 11207 and 370 Fountain Avenue, Brooklyn NY 11208 both in CSD 19, chartered to serve 824 students in grades K-8 for the 2021-22 school year growing to serve 959 students in grades K-10 by the 2023-24 school year, the last year of the current charter term, seeks an enrollment reduction to serve 824 students in grades K-8 through the 2023-24 school year.
  - Achievement First North Brooklyn Preparatory Charter School, located 200 Woodbine Street, Brooklyn NY 11221 in CSD 32, chartered to serve 824 students in grades K-8 for the 2021-22 school year growing to serve 959 students in grades K-10 by the 2023-24 school year, the last year of the current charter term, seeks an enrollment reduction to serve 824 students in grades K-8 through the 2023-24 school year.

- Bronx Charter School for Excellence, an education corporation with the authority to operate more than one school requests the following enrollment revisions:
  - O Bronx Charter School of Excellence 4, located at 4300 Murdock Avenue, Bronx, NY 10466 in Community School District ("CSD") 11, chartered to serve 450 students in grades K-4 for the 2021-22 school year and 540 students in grades K-5 for the 2022-23 school year, the last year of the current charter term, requests an enrollment decrease to serve 300 students in grades K-4 for the 2021-22 school year growing to serve 360 students in grades K-5 for the 2022-23 school year.
  - O Bronx Charter School of Excellence 5, located at 1946 Bathgate Avenue, Bronx, NY 10457 in CSD 9, chartered to serve 360 students in grades K-3 for the 2021-22 school year growing to serve 540 students in grades K-5 for the 2023-24 school year, the final year of the current charter term, requests an enrollment decrease to serve 240 students in grades K-3 for the 2021-22 school year growing to serve 360 students in grades K-5 for the 2023-24 school year.

seeks to add an at-risk preference to its admissions policies for the 2022-23 school year and beyond providing a preference for students enrolled in the Harlem RBI program. - **KIPP NYC Public Charter Schools**, an education corporation with the authority to operate more than one school requests the following enrollment revision:
  - o **KIPP Bronx Charter School II**, located at 501 Gerard Avenue, Bronx, NY 10451 in CSD 7, chartered to serve 370 students in grades K-1 and 5-6 for the 2021-22 school year growing to serve 735 students in grades K-3 and 5-8 for the 2023-24 school year, the final year of the current charter term, requests an enrollment decrease to serve 175 students in grades K and 6 for the 2021-22 school year growing to serve 697 students in grades K-2 and 5-8 for the 2023-24 school year. The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the revision application on or about July 14, 2021; and, 2) approved the revision on or about October 7, 2021.

- **Storefront Academy Charter School**, an education corporation with the authority to operate more than one school requests the following enrollment revision:
  - O Storefront Academy Harlem Charter School, located at 70 East 129<sup>th</sup> Street, New York, NY 10035 in CSD 5, chartered to serve 200 students in grades K-3 for the 2021-22 school year growing to serve 300 students in grades K-5 for the 2023-24 school year, the final year of the current charter term, requests an enrollment decrease to serve 100 students in grades K-3 for the 2021-22 school year growing to serve 150 students in grades K-5 for the 2023-24 school year. The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the revision application on or about August 4, 2021; and, 2) approved the revision on or about October 7, 2021.

Please take further Notice that the SUNY Trustees have sent or will send the proposed revisions to the Board of Regents for approval or action consent with the New York Charter Schools Act of 1998.
