This updated Notice, pursuant to New York Education Law § 2857(1), is to inform you that the State University of New York Board of Trustees (the “SUNY Trustees”), in its capacity as a charter authorizer, approved the following application to renew the charter of the charter school listed below:

**Elmwood Village Charter Schools**, an education corporation with the authority to operate more than one school, seeks to renew its authority to operate the following charter school

- **Elmwood Village Charter School Hertel**, located at 665 Hertel Avenue, Buffalo, NY 14207 in the Buffalo City School District, chartered to serve 350 students in grades K-6, sought a five year renewal of its charter commencing August 1, 2022. According to the renewal application, the school will grow to serve 450 students in grades K-8.

The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the renewal application on or about August 16, 2021; and, 2) approved the renewal on or about March 17, 2022.

Please take further Notice that the SUNY Trustees have sent or will send the proposed renewal to the Board of Regents for approval or action consent with the New York Charter Schools Act of 1998.
