



Broome Street Academy does not discriminate against or limit the admission of any student on any unlawful basis, including on the basis of ethnicity, national origin, gender, disability, intellectual ability, measure of achievement or aptitude, athletic ability, race, creed gender, national origin, religion, or ancestry. The Academy's focus is to meet the needs of all students throughout New York City, especially those who may be underserved based on their financial, cultural, or educational background. The Academy's lottery provides preference for students who are: homeless or transitionally housed, in foster care, receiving preventative services, or graduating from a low-achieving middle school. Half of the incoming seats for every new class beginning with the 2014-15 school year are reserved for youth who are homeless or transitionally housed, in foster care or receiving preventative services. Seventy-nine percent of our students are eligible for free or reduced price lunches.

Recruitment efforts during the 2015-2016 school year include: Developing relationships with and visiting foster care and social service agencies across NYC; Developing relationships with and visiting middle schools that have high populations of students who meet our highest riskfactors; and attending High School Fairs across the boroughs. We also hosted two Agency Breakfast events at the Academy. The agencies we partnered with and visited this year include: Abraham House, ACS, The Bronx Youth Center, Catholic Guardian Services, Center for Community Alternatives, Children's Aid Society, Citizens' Committee for the Children of NY, The Door, Good Shepherd Services, Esperanza, Exhalt Youth, Graham Windham, Jewish Community Center Association, Legal Aid Society, Martin De Porres Group Home, Mercy First, Neighborhood Defender Service, New Alternatives for Children, New York City Housing Authority, NY Foundling, Restart Academies of New York, SCO Family of Services, Sheltering Arms New York and University Settlement. Low-achieving middle schools that we have visited or invited to the Academy include: Beginning With Children Charter School, Bronx Park Middle School, Bronx Writing Academy, Emolior Academy, Fahari Academy, Great Oaks Charter School, P.S./I.S. 188, School for Global Leaders, TEP Charter School and Tomkins Square Middle School.

A new initiative within the Admissions Department has been the establishment of the Student Ambassadors Program. Student Ambassadors attended High School Fairs and agency and school visits. Student Ambassadors also assisted with the Agency Breakfast events, Open Houses and school group visits to the Academy. The Admissions Department will strengthen the Student Ambassador program for the 2016-2017 school year by selecting upperclassmen who are most passionate about the Academy and have them engage in the admissions process from the very beginning of the school year.

The paper application for admission to the Academy is available in English and Spanish. We added the services of School Mint, an easy to use web-based enrollment service, beginning in Fall of 2015. School Mint offers the application in English, Spanish and four other languages. School Mint has simplified and streamlined the application process, allowing data to be collected in one, user-friendly database. School Mint has also simplified and streamlined the Lottery process without compromising the integrity of the preference given to the most underserved students, which the Academy targets. The Academy recruits through advertising in the AM New York newspaper and in the Spanish newspaper El Diario. The Academy will also post ads in

Represent Magazine, whose articles are exclusively produced by foster care youth, which will broaden our reach to youth in care.

Nearly a quarter of our current student population has an Individualized Education Plan (IEP), allowing the school to utilize team-teaching practices to meet student needs and hold regularly scheduled meetings with students, caregivers, and social workers to review the content of each IEP for the student's benefit. We also have access to additional mental health services provided by our CBO, the Door through Article 31. The Academy has a comprehensive and robust student support team with four full time social workers, two guidance counselors and one transition counselor available for our students. Broome Street Academy works closely with the Committee on Special Education to ensure our student needs are being met in all aspects of their education. Partnership with The Door also allows Broome Street Academy students to have access to both in-school and after-school counseling services in addition to healthcare, academic support including tutoring, SAT prep and college and transition planning, legal support, and dinner every school night.
